About Madurai

Madurai in Tamil Nadu has a diversified industrial base with large units in automotive components, rubber products, food processing, sugar, chemicals, granite, and textiles, supported by multiple industrial estates around the city. Along with large-scale factories, the district also hosts tens of thousands of MSMEs in food, metal, plastic, rubber, textile, garments, electronics, electroplating and engineering, serving both domestic and export markets creating significant employment, making it one of the key industrial hubs of South Tamil Nadu. Several large and medium industries operate in and around Madurai, especially in automotive components, rubber, and agro-based sectors. Key examples mentioned in official industrial profiles include: National Sugar Mills at Mettupatti (Allanganallur), representing the sugar industry. TVS group units such as TVS Chakra (tyres) at Vellaripatti and Sundaram Auto Components, which focus on Tyres, auto components, and related rubber/metal parts. Hi-Tech Arai and Fenner India at Kochadai, manufacturing V-belts and power transmission products used in automobiles and machinery. Madurai district has three industrial estates developed to concentrate manufacturing activities and provide infrastructure like roads, power, and testing facilities: SIDCO Industrial Estate, K. Pudur; SIDCO Industrial Estate, Kappalur. It also hosts a textile technology support centre for improving textile quality and productivity: Hosiery Industrial Estate, Uranganpatti, which support garment/hosiery manufacturing. In addition to formal estates, industrial activity is geographically clustered: agricultural implement manufacturers concentrate around Melur, while food products, textile machinery, garments, chemicals, and stove/spare manufacturing are concentrated in and around urban Madurai. In the recent years Madurai city has also become Tier II IT hub increasing the employment scope for engineering students from multiple engineering institutions in around the city. The district industrial profile and recent surveys highlight several major sectors that dominate Madurai's economy. Recent overviews suggest that Madurai district has more than 32,500 registered micro, small, and medium enterprises. The region is also part of the Madurai–Tuticorin Industrial Corridor, which is projected to attract very large investments and encourage more medium and large industries to set up around the city. This industrial base supports employment for both skilled and unskilled workers and reinforces Madurai's role as a major industrial and educational hub in southern Tamil Nadu.

About MADITSSIA

In Madurai, which is the headquarters of the Southern Districts, Madurai District Tiny and Small Scale Industries known as MADITSSIA, has been working for the industrial development of the southern districts for the past 51 years. The association has 1500 direct members and 7500 indirect members. The Standards Council of India has recognized it as Gold Standard Certified association for business membership in association with the National Accreditation Board. It has played a vital role in the transition of the economy of Madurai by conducting various exhibitions, seminars, and workshops that have showcased the latest technology and newest innovations in their respective fields.
